- Implicit Knowledge of Sounds

- Implicit Knowledge of Form-Meaning Pairs
 - Arbitrary: house, beit, casa
 - Compositional: 'I went to a housewarming party'
- Productivity
 - "Infinite use of finite means."
 - 'Colorless green ideas sleep furiously.'

Division of grammatical from ungrammatical speech

- Exists at the level of an individual speaker
- Separate from ability to perform speech acts well

► "Grammar"

- Prescriptive grammar: Rules from English class
- Descriptive grammar: (linguistics) How do people speak?

Universal Grammar

- Theorized rules which govern what languages are possible
- Facilitates the acquisition of a particular language by conferring inductive biases

- ► What would make a language 'impossible'?
 - Lack of recursion
 - Linear ordering
 - (2) a. Julia's₁ brother helped her_{1,2}
 - b. Julia₁ helped her_{2,*1}

- ► Language and Thought
 - Strong Sapir-Whorf: Language bounds thought
 - ► What's a wug? https://en.wiktionary.org/wiki/wug
 - Weak Sapir-Whorf: Language influences thought
 - Colors: https://ismy.blue/
